

PREANESTHETIC BLOODWORK RELEASE FORM - for animals 8 years & older

For animals 8 years of age and older, we REQUIRE PREANESTHETIC BLOODWORK to be performed on their pet prior to any procedure involving anesthesia. This bloodwork will reveal any underlying liver and/or kidney abnormalities which can cause problems with anesthesia. If the blood test results are abnormal, the doctor may elect to change the type of anesthetic drugs selected for your pet in order to minimize anesthetic complications.

HOME AGAIN MIRCOCHIP

All owners have the option of having a HOME AGAIN MICROCHIP placed under pet's skin for identification purposes. Shelters and veterinary hospitals routinely scan for these chips when presented with a lost animal. The microchip can be placed when the animal is not anesthetized but, because it is a rather large needle, we recommend placing it while the animal is asleep. The cost is \$59.50 for the microchip, plus a lifelong registration fee of \$17.50 to the company. Initial below:
